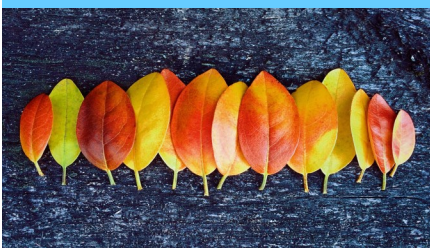

North Mason School District conducts specific activities for the purposes of locating, evaluating and identifying students ages birth to twenty-one with suspected disabilities and who reside within school district boundaries. Approximately ten to fifteen percent of all children have a disability that hinders their educational development. Early identification of disabilities assists parents, students and schools in the design of appropriate educational services.

The Next Step: If you have concerns about your child's development...CALL US! North Mason School District offers screening clinics for children to provide information to parents on school-related development. Parents are encouraged to take advantage of this FREE service, especially if you have questions regarding your child's development. Vision, hearing, and motor coordination screening are part of what is provided, as well as information on how well your child is doing with language, learning and behavior skills. Reminder From The Health Room

Any student with a fever should be kept home. When your child is fever free for 24 hours (without fever-reducing medicine) and no other symptoms, they may return to school.

Any student with vomiting should be kept home until symptom free for 24 hours.

Any student with watery diarrhea should be kept home until symptom free for 24 hours.

Any student with infected or red, watery eyes should be kept home until diagnosed by a health care provider or is symptom free.

Any student with an undiagnosed skin rash or open, infected sores should be kept home until diagnosed by a health care provider, or it is resolved.

Any student who has a medical procedure done under anesthesia or sedation should, in most cases, remain home for at least 24 hours.
