

1 **Qualification Of Attendance And Placement**

2 **Entrance Qualifications for Kindergarten Program**

3 As a minimum, eligibility for the exemption from the age requirement will be based upon an
4 analysis of the child's (1) physical, health and motor development; (2) social and emotional de-
5 velopment; (3) approaches toward learning; (4) language, literacy and communication; and (5)
6 cognition and general knowledge. Where feasible, assessment devices will be used that will
7 permit students who are to be considered for exemption to be compared to the level of perfor-
8 mance that would be expected of children with a chronological age of 5 years for kindergarten
9 and 6 years for first grade in each of the areas of ability.

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11 **Admission Of Students Aged Twenty-One Or Older**

12 The student shall petition the superintendent for admission.

13 The petition shall identify the student's name, age, address and grade level or program of study.

14 If approved, the petition shall specify the tuition fee to be paid, shall be signed by the student and
15 the superintendent and shall constitute the written agreement required by law. It shall be retained
16 as a public document and made available to the state Superintendent of Public Instruction upon
17 request.

18 The tuition fee shall be calculated in the same way the state Superintendent of Public Instruction
19 determines the cost of educating a student in the district, except that a disabled student who turns
20 twenty-one during the school year shall only pay that amount of money deemed as "excess cost."
