How to get on Microsoft Teams / School Email

Every student in North Mason Secondary has a school email which allows them to log into their Office365 account anywhere to get on Word, PowerPoint, Outlook (email), Teams, etc.

This email is the student's network username @ northmasonschoools.org. A student's network name is the first 5 letters of their last name, first three letters of their first name, and a 3-digit number (usually 000 or 001)

Example: Jimmy Johnson's email address would be johnsjim000@northmasonschoools.org

Let your teacher know if you've forgotten your password or can't remember your username. Your teacher will put in a request with technology to have your password reset and can look up your email.

What is Microsoft Teams? Many teachers are making their assignments available via Teams, which is set up like a virtual classroom. Students can download and turn-in assignments with no need to print, ask their teacher questions, and interact with other students through content-based discussions.

You can find Teams in Office365.

How to get/drop off Work Packets

Via your Bus

Homework requests must be made to your bus driver so they know to request a work packet. Have student's name, school, and classes available to give to the bus driver.

Give back work packets in a sealed bag with student's name, teacher's name, and class period written on it.

At the High School

High School Main Office is open on Fridays 10AM – 1PM for work packet pick-up and drop off.

Have student's name, school, and classes available to give to staff.

Give back work packets in a sealed bag with student's name, teacher's name, and class period written on it.

How to Keep Informed and Communicate with Remind

Each teacher at the school has Remind classes set up that can send/receive text messages, as well as be accessible online or via the Remind app. Ask your teacher what your child's class code is in order to sign up for notifications. Class codes can be added directly via the Remind App or Website, or texted directly to 81010 to sign up for text notifications.
