SUVs Vs. Cars

Most Americans today drive either a car or an SUV. SUV is short for sport utility vehicle. Both cars and SUVs offer benefits that the other does not. SUVs are larger and offer more room for both passengers and cargo. SUVs are better for taking larger items as the back end of SUVs are bigger than the trunks on cars. Some SUVs even have a third row of seating, which can seat up to 7 adults. Cars are limited to a maximum of seating 5 adults comfortably. Due to being smaller, cars usually get better gas mileage. This helps save car owners money. Cars are easier to maneuver and fit into small garages and parking spaces more easily. SUVs can have the ability to go off-roading. This is an activity that many people enjoy that includes driving over rough terrain and areas that cars could not travel. Some cars are built for performance and speed unlike SUVs. If a person wants to go really fast, their best bet is in a car. SUVs are often preferred by people living in areas where winter weather gets harsh. No matter which you live, both cars and SUVs are fun to drive.
