

Hello Geometry Students and Families!

What an interesting time we live in! We first wanted to tell students and families that we are grateful for the patience and effort you are putting in during these weeks we will be out of school. Please keep yourselves healthy and safe, and we will be providing you with as much information as possible via our online services such as email and the Remind app.

Additionally, specifically for geometry, we have decided to continue our online curriculum only during this time. This means Mathia, Mathia, and more Mathia. This is an excellent resource as it contains step-by-step instruction, worked examples, and additional resources to continue your learning. We have already been working through Mathia this year, and we will continue our bookwork and additional learning when we see each other again in April.

If you do not have the ability to access Mathia, please email me or message me through the Remind app as soon as possible. The school district is working on a plan to potentially distribute technology for students in need.

As a reminder for students, here is how to get to Mathia and login:

1. Go to <https://www.carnegielearning.com/login/#/>
2. Input your username
  - a. It is a 5 digit number
    - i. If you do not remember it, just send me an email or remind message and I will get it to you ASAP
3. Input your password (we all have the same one)
  - a. hmsalg1
4. Finishing signing in and begin where you were last working

As a reminder to students: don't be afraid to write out the math! You are not required to do the math in your head! Grab a writing utensil and something to write on, and actually do the work! Take this learning seriously and see how many problems you can complete without help. The goal is not to go as fast as you can through the modules, it is to learn the material within them.

Please know that details are still being worked out, and there may be changes to the above timeline as we get more information in the coming days and weeks. We will keep you up to date when we get the new information through email and the Remind app.

If you have any questions or get stuck on any content, please know that you can always email or message your teacher on the Remind app for help. There may also be additional resources available online that your teacher may share with you during the coming weeks. Know that we miss seeing you around the halls here at Hawkins Middle School and look forward to reconnecting in April.
