Disrespect <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Arguing-Back Talk Rolling Eyes /Sighing/ Making Faces/ Huffing, etc. Lying/Cheating on daily work Littering Equipment or materials not returned 	Disrespect <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Talking back/argumentative Intentional disruption Spitting on a person Lying to be deceptive
Defiance <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Not working/Not participating/Not listening Refusing to follow directions Not trying 	Defiance <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Extreme, blatant refusal to comply with reasonable request Will not identify self or provide information upon request Student walks out in anger—no pass
Disruption <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Making noises / Tapping on desks or tables Out of seat without cause Talking: off topic/during instruction or work time Frequent restroom visits with permission Tossing items to someone 	Disruption <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Behavior causing sustained interruption of a class or activity Sustained loud talk, yelling, or screaming
Tardy <ul style="list-style-type: none"> not in classroom when the bell stops ringing 	Skipping Class: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Frequent tardies &/or 10 minutes or more late to class Leaving early without permission (Off school location/restricted area)
Inappropriate Language: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Swearing—surprise, habit; Inappropriate joking-teasing Negative—threats talk (general) Name calling (joking); Putdowns (joking) 	Abusive Language: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Screaming/yelling/blatant swearing F-you, flipping off (anger) Taunting another student
Technology Violation: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Unauthorized use of technology Texting / Earphones in Website or WWW use violation 	Technology Violation: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Pornography: captured/viewed Image capture-harming others Intentionally deleting to avoid punishment
Physical Contact: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Poking Tripping/Bumping into another Throwing something at another person Horseplaying (rough or other) 	Fighting: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Student involved in mutual incident involving physical violence (anger) Fight promotion
	Physical Aggression/Assault: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Spitting/Throwing at/on (anger) Hitting, pushing, punching (mean joking)
Dress Code: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Underwear showing; Overexposure/too tight thus revealing Face is covered (to avoid being identified) Drug and alcohol themed clothing 	Dress Code: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Gang related apparel Overtly suggestive/violent clothing
Property Misuse: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Minor vandalism (writing) Stealing minor items (i.e. hats, candy/food) Not following laptop check out procedures 	Property Damage/Vandalism: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Intentionally breaking-damaging property Damaging/altering computer equipment Defacing property (tagging)
	Theft/Forgery: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Stealing major items Signing another's name Cheating on tests/projects or intentionally stealing other's work
Public Display of Affection: kissing; extended hugging; sitting/lying on another	Bullying: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> The delivery of direct or technology-based messages that involve intimidation, teasing, taunting, threats, or name-calling
	Harassment: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> The delivery of disrespectful messages in any format related to gender, ethnicity, race, sex, religion, disability, physical features, or other protected class.
	Arson: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Student plans and/or participates in malicious burning of property
	Bomb Threat/False Alarm: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Student sending false message regarding possible explosive material on/near /pending/alarm pull
	Weapons-Combustibles: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Possessing: a lighter, bomb making materials, knife/blade, firearm or ammunition
	Alcohol/Drugs/Tobacco: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Possessing cigarettes, vaping paraphernalia; alcohol; controlled substances
